## **Supplementary Regulations**

- 1. The Southsea Motor Club Ltd will organise a Clubmen's Historic Sporting Trial co-promoted with the 750 Motor Club., on Sunday 28<sup>th</sup> December 2025 at **Head Down**, **Buriton**, **near Petersfield**, **Hants**, **GU31 5SN**. **Entrance at what3words reference: bottle.inflamed.unsigned**.
- 2. The Meeting will be governed by the General Regulations of Motorsport UK (Incorporating the provisions of the International Sporting code of the FIA), these SR's and any written instructions the organising clubs may issue for the event.
- 3. Motorsport UK Permit Number: 205224
- 4. The event is open to all fully elected members of one of the organising clubs and members of the following invited clubs, BTRDA, NPTCC, MCC, HSCC, VSCC, MAC, KBCC, Woolbridge MC, Falcon Motor Club, Dellow Register, Midlands Trials Car Club, Isle of Wight Car Club and Ilkley and District MC.
- 5. Public Roads will not be used to link sections. There will be 6 sections on private land to be attempted at least 3 times. The entry will be split into groups starting at different hills to enable the programme to be completed.
  Scrutineering starts at 9.00am. First test: 10.30am. Any competitor not signed on by 10.15am may be excluded.
- 6. All cars will comply with the Motorsport UK technical regulations and with the Historic and Post Historic Sporting Trials Car Formula (Motorsport UK NCR Chapter 17, Appendix 6). Historic cars must be fitted with Blockley 4.50/5.00 x 18 tyres to the driven wheels. Permitted tyres for Post Historics as per Motorsport UK NCR Chapter 17.
- 7. A minimum tyre pressure will be applied on the day at the discretion of the Clerk of the Course. Checks may be carried out to confirm compliance. A maximum of 12 penalty points can be applied for each breach of the rule.
- 8. Classes: HISTORIC and POST HISTORIC as defined by HSTA.
- 9. Awards to be presented as follows:-

1st overall (Historic only)

1st Historic

2nd Historic

1st Post Historic

2nd Post Historic

A Special "Spirit of the Day" Award to be presented at the Organisers discretion.
